Position Summary

The Dental Director provides clinical leadership while delivering direct patient care. This role oversees the quality and consistency of dental services. In addition, this role treats patients by diagnosing, preventing, and managing diseases, injuries, and malformations of the teeth, jaw, and mouth. The Dental Director balances department leadership with hands-on clinical responsibilities to support both patient care and program effectiveness.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide skilled and compassionate dental care to patients
- Perform comprehensive dental examinations and diagnose oral health conditions
- Interpret dental x-rays and diagnostic tests
- Perform restorative procedures such as fillings, crowns, bridges, and dentures
- Conduct surgical procedures as needed including extractions
- Collaborate with oral health specialists in the community for patient referrals
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date patient records
- After hours call coverage and triage of dental emergencies
- Supervising staff and volunteer hygienists and dentists
- Perform quarterly and annual reviews of dental staff
- Assist in the development and implementation of patient care policies
- Oversees daily practice operations, including appointment scheduling, billing procedures, cleaning, and occupational health and safety

- Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) or Doctor of Dental Medicine (DMD) degree from an accredited institution
- Possess a valid Michigan dental license and other credentials required by law
- Strong knowledge of dental procedures, tools, and diagnostics
